## Introduction

Deliverable 2.1. has developed and published a database of European wide NGOs working in the P/CVE sector of the criminal justice field.

## Work Package Overview

Work Package 2 problematises the fact that CSOs and NGOs functioning in the P/CVE sector are not adequately screened and evaluated at the organisational level. In this framework, the fundamental goal of this WP is to set up a comprehensive selection process of non-institutional actors, entailing thorough screening and assessment evaluation criteria regarding their recruitment and final selection. The criteria should be homogenous across countries and programmes to establish a coherent and rigorous framework. WP2 intends to achieve the above-mentioned through the following activities:

- Developing and creating a database of European NGOs working with the criminal justice sector,
- Developing and piloting an evaluation framework to assess NGO trustworthiness and capability.

## Section 1 – Database Overview

### Database of European NGOs and Initiatives

As described in the DoA, a database of non-governmental organisations working with extremist/radical individuals (or with those who are potentially vulnerable to engaging in radical activities and, therefore, be in danger of initiating their radicalisation process) was created.

During the Kick-off Meeting, project partners discussed whether the database should be filled in by the responsible organisation (KMOP) via traditional desk research or if an open call to NGOs was more appropriate. Issues of data privacy and consent from the NGOs part were also discussed. Timewise, the first option was chosen, and an objection form has been created for the NGOs that might want to be removed from the database.

The database consists of 152 organisations and initiatives around Europe (i.e., EU member states as well as Switzerland, Albania, Kosovo, Serbia, Montenegro, Bosnia and Herzegovina and Russia). The work was conducted and coordinated by KMOP, and partners have also contributed with relevant data input.

## Section 2 – Methodology utilised

The database development took place in three phases. Initially, KMOP's research team conducted discussions internally regarding the collection of the NGOs and the methodology. Within this framework, a consortium meeting was planned to decide on the organisational aspects of the task along with the



information that would be collected. Later, in accordance with what was agreed within the consortium, a desk research phase was conducted to identify relevant organisations; this phase was supported by IPS, CSD, FUNDEA, PPHS and IACFP. Lastly, when the organisations with all the relevant information were collected, initial attempts were made by IPS to upload the database online in order to assess technical difficulties and other necessities that would arise. Following this, the database was finetuned and steadily uploaded.

The specific criteria that were deemed as necessary for the collection of the NGOs are the following:

- Achieving European wide representation
- Selecting organisations with relevant expertise
- Ensuring NGOs of various sizes are included

Even though the criteria were set, in some cases, organisations had a broader scope than envisaged, and P/CVE was just part of the work conducted; these types of organisations have also been included.

### Section 3 – The online NGO database

The database developed within T2.1.1 was co-jointly implemented online in a unique networking platform operated by IPS\_Innovative Prison Systems named *Corrections Direct – The Global Prisons and Probation Directory* (<https://www.corrections.direct>).

CORRECTIONS Direct is a networking platform that brings together prison and probation administration agencies, specialised suppliers, experts, researchers, and community organisations.

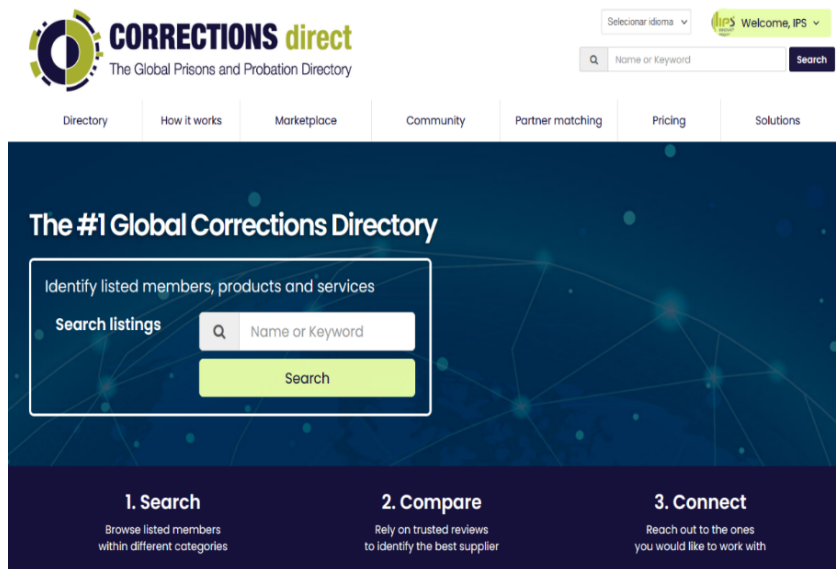


Figure 1. Global Corrections Directory

The platform's goal is to gather all stakeholders in one easily searchable directory and to promote connections and partnership opportunities between the community members.



With currently over 1400 members, CORRECTIONS Direct offers a wide range of functionalities to agencies and organisations looking for connections or visibility. They can get involved by sharing information about their work in their profiles, publishing community articles or videos, and disseminating events in the shared calendar.

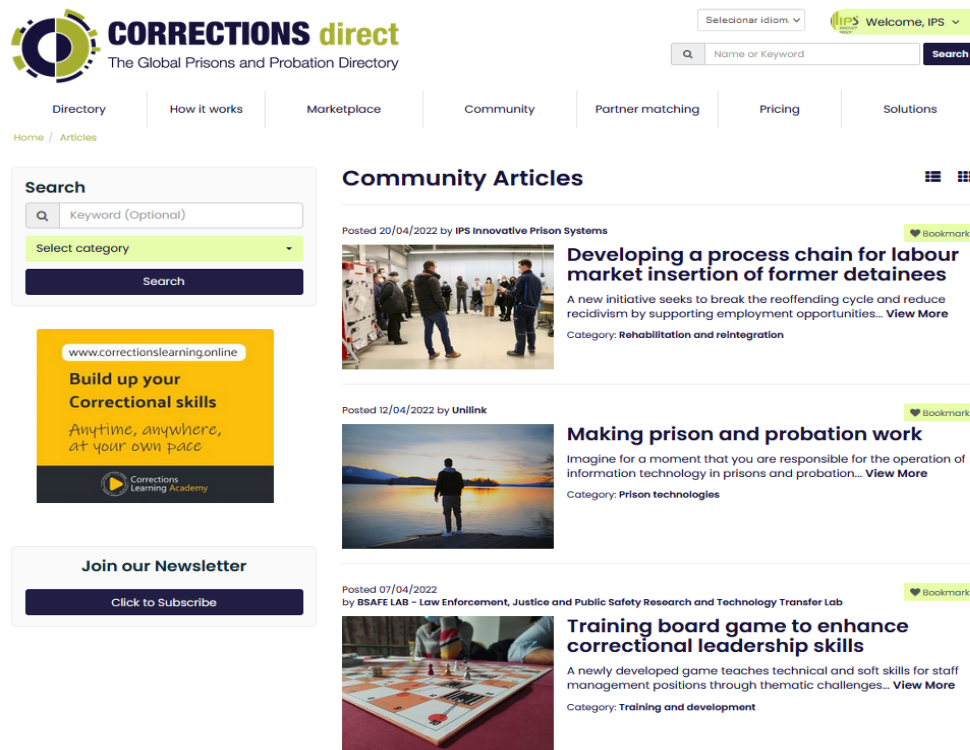


Figure 2. Community articles

This way, contacts were to be integrated so communication between NGOs working in the field of radicalisation prevention in corrections and prison and probation administrations can occur on a specific platform, centralising the three stakeholders (i.e., prison, probation, and community) in a single network. Besides, the upload of the database to CORRECTIONS Direct allows higher visibility for these organisations beyond their dedicated results page, thus fulfilling the objective of the project and aiding in the following activities.

After the agreement between the Task Leader and the contributing partner on the platform's nuances and features, the database was uploaded to the online platform CORRECTIONS Direct.

The process of uploading the database collected by partners involved the direct import divided into several fields (e.g., name, description, logo, website, country, email). For some of the organisations, there was no logo immediately available to upload. In these instances, the template logo was temporarily placed while further effort was made into identifying an adequate logo for the organisation.

In addition, it can be shared with a focus on a specific country of origin through URLs in the format <https://www.corrections.direct/country/csos> (CSOS stands for civil society organisations). Furthermore,



a direct link was included within the MIRAD project’s website, disseminating the product and facilitating its access to all website visitors.

All the gathered information is available in the organisation's profile (e.g., name, description, website link, and location). The organisation's collected email addresses are not publicly displayed, but a message form will allow contact requests. After a manual spam verification, these messages will be redirected in full to the registered email address. Therefore, the General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) concerns are fully covered.

## Section 4 – Concluding remarks

The creation of an online NGO database is an important aspect of centralising and harmonising information on relevant organisations for P/CVE in the criminal justice system. The realisation of this task supports several key aspects that the MIRAD project strives to achieve, such as:

- enhancing the efficiency of radicalisation disengagement and reintegration programmes,
- raising awareness and promoting the joint implementation of risk assessment tools,
- attracting, engaging and collaborating with the key stakeholders of prison and probation service staff and NGOs professionals,
- constructing and piloting a methodological evaluation approach (and associated instrument) for ensuring the trustworthiness and capability of NGO's as non-institutional partners involved in disengagement and reintegration programme,
- developing capacity-building interventions on the use of risk-assessment instrument (i.e., the IRS tool),
- providing innovative training offers in the field of radicalisation assessment, harnessing the benefits of by technological advances,
- promoting cross-sectoral and inter-institutional collaboration models and protocols.

The database will be continuously shared, fed and open for access throughout the project, as well as help in the following activities, namely regarding the involvement of non-governmental organisations.
